PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

**PROPOSED GRANT OF EASEMENT OVER DISTRICT PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA FOR
WATER UTILITY EASEMENT**

Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to California Education Code Section 17556, et seq., the Board of Trustees of Santa Clara Unified School District ("Board") has adopted Resolution No. 20-22 Giving Notice of Intent to Grant a Water Utility Easement to the City of Santa Clara. The easement is over separate portions of real property on the Cabrillo Middle School campus at 2550 Cabrillo Avenue, Santa Clara 95051 (the "Easement"). The Easement is for the purpose of construction, maintenance, repair and similar activities related to water utilities.

A public hearing will be held regarding the Easement during the regular meeting of the Santa Clara Unified School District Board of Trustees on **Thursday, September 10, 2020, commencing at 7:00 PM**, or as soon as practicable thereafter. The meeting will be conducted virtually over the internet. See the District's website <https://www.santaclarausd.org> for information regarding the meeting and public participation. Any interested person may be heard during the hearing regarding the matter of conveying the Easements. If no formal protest to the Grant of Easements is received, the Board may at the end of the hearing adopt the Resolution(s) to dedicate the Easement(s) by a two-thirds vote of its members.
