Full-time service for 75% of the days in the Counselor/Psychologist work year is required to qualify for each year of outside experience credit.

Counselors/Psychologist work a 198-day work year. New certificated employees are paid for an additional orientation day at the beginning of the school year.

Class I *A Bachelor's Degree plus 30 semester units or a Bachelor's Degree & completion of a credential program.**

Class II *A Bachelor's Degree plus 45 semester units.*

Class III *A Bachelor's Degree plus 60 semester units.*

**Counselors/Psychologist will be placed on the salary schedule based on units will remain at that class level until the actual number of units is accrued.*

If hired with more than twelve (12) years creditable experience will be placed at the salary grade closest to the salary from their last school district but not less, unless there is no equivalent salary grade on the District's Counselor/Psychologist Salary Schedule.
