Field Usage Rules

1. SCUSD programs have priority use of all fields.
2. User is responsible for monitoring weather conditions and evaluating playing fields when there is a threat of rain, lightening or dangerous conditions. In the event of weather cancellation for any reason, please contact Facilitron as soon as the decision to cancel has been made. The District shall cancel events if field or weather conditions could cause harm.
3. No site facility improvements or additions shall be made without written consent from the District. All improvements are subject to (DSA) Division of State Architect approval.
4. No climbing on fences, backstops, or buildings. Backstops shall not be moved.
5. No animals, including pets, are allowed on the playing fields, unless allowed by law.
6. No tampering with irrigation systems and no playing on areas scheduled for watering.
7. Exterior sound amplification is not allowed by outside users, unless previously approved in writing by the site on Facilitron.
8. Portable lights are prohibited from use on all district facilities, unless previously approved in writing by the site on Facilitron.
9. Fields are not prepped and do not include use of bases or soccer goals; nor are they available.
10. Portable toilets may be permitted on a site by site basis. The school Principal or designee will determine the designated location. Approved users will pay for the rental and maintenance of the toilet, coordinate the cleaning schedule, and provide a lock for security. It must be secured to an immovable object, cleaned regularly and be removed immediately following the last game of the season. If vandalized, it must be dealt with and the correction made that day or by the following day if reported after 12 noon.
11. Teams must adhere to scheduled days and hours of use. Absolutely no league personnel or participants can be on a school field while school is in session. At schools with After School Programs, the field permit start times may vary. Verify participants understand your permitted field's reservation time. Participants are not allowed on the field prior to the scheduled reservation.
12. Each organization's designated representative must remain onsite during the entire activity. If asked, the designated representative must be able to show the permit (digital is okay) during the reservation time period. Without it, the user will be asked to leave the fields immediately.
13. All trash must be picked up at the end of facility use every day and trash must be taken with the user, not placed in the school garbage can or dumpster.
14. Vehicles must be parked in approved parking areas. Vehicles will also be subject to ticketing or tow away if parked on the blacktop or on the fields. This can also lead to your permit being revoked.
15. Weekend use can begin no earlier than 7:00 a.m.
16. Good sportsmanship is expected at all times, especially between leagues sharing a field.
17. If you allow another group, not permitted, to use the field you have a permit to, all your permits will be revoked.
